



As your new President, I want you to know I am going to work hard to make the club a little more interesting. I have a great board behind me. We have decided to make all but one of our tournaments two-day events so more members can get a shot at participation. Only the weakfish tournament will last for one day. Some fishing regulations are changing. The Fluke season will run from May 14 to September 28. The minimum size is $16 \frac{1}{2}$ inches with an 8 fish limit.

BE CAREFUL EATING FISH by Dick Vesper

Please read this article. There were so many confusing stories about the chemicals in fish that I decided to do some homework. The principal sources were the states of NJ, De, Pa and Consumer Reports. The health threat is usually stated for two separate groups of people:

- 1. <u>High Risk Individuals</u> which includes infants, pregnant women, children under 15, nursing mothers and women of child bearing age
- 2. General Population everyone else

My findings are summarized below.

ADVISORY/PROHIBITION FOR NJ

Other suggestions I received include

- From the FDA: It is safe for high risk individuals to east 12 ounces per week of other (non-prohibited) fish species.
- Other suggestions received for all species:
 - Smell before buying fish trust your nose.
 - Wash the fish thoroughly
 - Eat variety rather than only one species
- Suggestions for species with warnings
 - Washing and trimming does not remove the government advisory
 - Be wary of the oils/etc. coming from cooking
 - Before cooking remove organs, head, skin dark fatty tissue, backbone and belly.
 - Remove the fat and darker meat before cooking
 - Eat smaller to mid-size fish
 - Bake or broil the fish
 - Avoid batter or breading
 - Don't fry in a pan
 - Don't reuse juices etc. for soup or sauces

6. Only one fish can be entered for each fisherman


7. All fishing must be by boat with rod and reel


8. Fishing boundaries are Barnegat Inlet to Wreck Inlet in bay waters only
