## REGULATORY UPDATE by Dave Sikorski

The battle between the folks who would love to end fishing and the folks who love fishing continues.

If you have not already heard, the 2008 NJ **Fluke** regulations will be: 18" minimum length, 8-fish bag limit, with a season opening May 24 and closing on September 7.

As of October, 2007 the bag limit on **Weakfish** was reduced to 6 fish. This carries over into 2008. The minimum size is still 13" and the season is open all year.

We nearly lost our right to fish for **Tautog**, when the NMFS threatened a moratorium in NJ unless NJ implemented a cutback in our regulations. Once we know the new regulations we will post them on our web site, and in the next newsletter.

In May, the Division of Fish and Wildlife will publish the official saltwater regulations. We will provide a link to the new regulations on our website, once they are published.

There are several bills in process in the NJ legislature. We will give you updates on these as they progress, and we may need support from the club's membership to get some pushed through (letters, etc.).
