# **RECIPES FOR THE DISCRIMINATING COOK** by John Borick

#### TWO CHEESE FLOUNDER ROLLS

1 pound of flounder fillet (4 pieces)

1 egg beaten

1/3 cup of Parmesan cheese

3 tablespoons of yellow cornmeal

3 tablespoons of flour

½ tablespoons each, salt and pepper

4 slices of American cheese

2 tablespoons of margarine, melted

Pat fillets dry on paper towels, then dip into beaten eggs. Combine Parmesan cheese, cornmeal, flour, salt and pepper. Turn fillets in mixture to coat. Position slice of American cheese on each fillet and roll, securing with toothpick. Place in greased baking dish and drizzle with melted margarine. Bake at 350 degrees in oven for about 20 minutes or until fish flakes easily with fork

#### **JERSEY CLAM PIE** by Flo Williams

Pastry for two-crust pie ½ cup chopped onion 6 tbsp. butter ½ cup all-purpose flour 3 cups clam juice (save juice from clams)

4 cups chopped clams (chowder size) 5 oz. frozen peas Chopped canned pimento 2 cups chopped potatoes

#### Prepare pastry

Cook onion in butter till tender. Blend flour, 1 tsp. salt, add all other ingredients. Cook until potatoes are tender then add pepper to taste. Pour into prepared pastry and bake at 450 degrees for 20 to 25 minutes.

# IS FLUKE FISHING ALMOST OVER? By

Dave Sikorski & Dick Vesper

The NMFS wants to reduce the total allowable landings (TAL) for fluke from the 23.6 million lbs the states were assigned in 2006, to 5.2 million lbs in 2007.

The effect in NJ will be that each of our approximately 800,000 Fluke anglers will be allowed to keep only 0.57 fluke for the entire year! Why, it's not because the fish are in danger of extinction, it's not because the fishery is over fished. In fact, the Fluke population has more than doubled to 112 million lbs, since 1993. It is because an arbitrary target of 204 million lbs of Fluke is not likely to be achievable by the year 2010 (as mandated by the 2000 revision of the Magnuson Stephens Act).

The NMFS, which has previously lost a lawsuit to environmentalists over not meeting fisheries targets, is pushing for this TAL reduction to avoid another lawsuit.

Unfortunately, the real losers will be the Fluke anglers and the businesses and workers that depend on this fishery.

Your favorite Bait and Tackle shop could easily be sold to land developers for conversion to Condos.

The VHFC Regulatory Committee will provide additional information as we get any. In the meantime, we are helping JCAA in launching one or more initiatives to counter this serious threat

We will probably be sending you all a sample letter and a request that you send it to one or more of your Government representatives - to be named with the request.
