# SURF TOURNAMENT IN SPRING INSTEAD OF FALL PROVES TO BE A RESOUNDING SUCCESS By Basil Dubrosky

The surf tournament was held on May 6 at 20<sup>th</sup> Street in Ship Bottom. It had been moved from fall to spring to increase the chances that fish would be caught and the plan worked like a charm. Things started off fast when Dave Sikorski caught the winning Striped Bass at 6:30 AM. This line-sider weighed in at 9 pounds 10 ounces and measured 30 inches long. John Borick and Jerry Papp also scored with Bass prior to 7 AM. Ron Nachmann caught his first 3 Striped Bass in the surf later in the day.

The Bass were in the surf and cooperating. In total, 14 Striped Bass were caught. A surprising statistic was that during the 12 hours of fishing

only Striped Bass were caught. No other fish species.

The weather was warm and sunny. The participants enjoyed reminiscing or talking strategy between the action and club members were always nearby to help bring fish up from the surf.

The spring surf tournament will probably become a regular event and we encourage all club members to sign up and join in on the fun.

Note: your dues have to be paid before you catch an eligible fish.
