Note: your dues have to be paid before you catch an eligible fish.

Then I got my hit, at first I thought it might be a Blue by the way my rod bent but there was not a lot of fight so I am thinking Skate, Shark or the Mother of all Sea Robins, but by the time I got it along side of the boat, (I had let out a lot of line I thought I might be fishing in Atlantic City I had put so much line out), but up comes my 22" 4lb Fluke, it was not going to be the fish of the Month or Year and I knew I wasn't going to win any awards with it But it was my FISH and it made my day and that's what it is all about.

## North & South Bay Tournament on June 23rd, 2007

This fishing event is open to all active members, co-members, & junior anglers (2007 dues paid) with or without boats. Entry Fee is \$10 per angler & all entry fees will be distributed as prize money.

We are asking all participating boats to fly the club flag, so we can identify each other and aid one another as needed.

**Entries:** Prizes will only be awarded to current (dues paid) members who have signed up for this event before it starts; either at a club meeting or by mail received before the event. We need you to sign the Signup Sheet and thereby acknowledge your understanding of the rules and responsibilities for the event.

**Prizes:** One third of the total entry fees will be awarded for each of the heaviest keeper Fluke, Weakfish and Bluefish (the bluefish must be over 2 pounds). In the event that no fish of a species is caught, prize money will be split among other species. In case of equal weights, the longer fish will win & if lengths are equal, the first fish weighed in wins.
