## OCTOBER'S FISHING REPORT

**OCTOBER 22, 2005** by Bill Jann

Catch: 3 stripers (one @ 37", 18lb 6oz), 2 short stripers, miscellaneous fish including many skates, some sharks, robins and one blue.

Went out with Bill Dabney and John Nonnenmacher, on the Ice Wine, to do some serious striper fishing . Bill and John had gotten a bushel of clams (from Columbia, yet!) and a few dozen live bunker. It was a rainy, cloudy day, cool but not much wind—perfect for fishing.

We anchored up on a rip that Jim Hutchinson had told Bill about, in about 14 feet of water off the Coast Guard Station; slack tide at first, and no stripers.

Once the outgoing water started to run we got some bites; 2 stripers in the 7 to 8 pound class and the big one at 18+ pounds. All the stripers were caught on clams, with fish finder rigs, blues and robins on the bunker.

When I hooked the big one, Bill also tied into what turned out to be a very large skate, so we had a hectic 20 minutes or so. Thanks to John's net skills though, all ended up well. We made our way back just as darkness fell and eventually got to Fish Heads to register the fish.

**Stefano's Clam Chowder** from Stefano's Seafood, Beach Haven, NJ – contributed by Al Tichenor

4 quarts clam juice	1 quart chopped NJ clams
1 pint diced onion	1 pint diced carrots
1 pint diced celery	1 pint diced potatoes
1 ½ pint crushed tomatoes	1 tsp salt
1 tsp pepper	1 tsp Old Bay seasoning
Fresh rosemary	Fresh thyme
Fresh basil	Makes 7 quarts or 28 cups

### Directions:

Put clam juice, onions, carrots, celery and tomatoes in 10 quart stock pot and bring to a boil and simmer for 15 minutes, then add potatoes, clams and spices. Cook for 10 minutes over low heat until potatoes are tender.
