If you have weighed in the largest fish of a particular species for the calendar year 2012, then you win the FOY trophy for that species. Note: your dues have to be paid before you catch an eligible fish.

**FISHING REPORT** from Dave Spendiff for September 14, 2012.

It was 4:45 am, September 13, 2012 when Walt Narkiewicz, Bill Dabney, Don DeCaro and Dave Spendiff met at the Mill Creek Recreation Center parking lot. We all piled into Dave's car and headed for the Belmar Marina and the Big Mohawk III to meet Joe Marone and his brother for a day of fluke fishing. We went onboard a little before 6:00 am to select our prime fishing spots only to find that the port side bow locations were already occupied with rods, so, we took the positions as close as we could to the bow on the port side. We pulled away from the dock at 7:00, headed out the Shark River and turned north. The mates said we were going to fish the Sandy Hook Reef and hoped that we had all brought loads of gear because we were going to leave a lot in the reef. None of us had ever heard of the Sandy Hook Reef and figured they were really going to actually fish the Shrewsbury Rocks and just wanted to dupe us. When the "start fishing" horn blasted we were about a mile off of the Sandy Hook beach and definitely over a gear-gobbling reef!

The boat provided squid strips and spearing, but no one that we could see on the port side used it. Instead, we used 6" Gulp grubs or

swimming mullets in Pink Shine, New Penny, Nuclear Chicken, White Glow or Chartreuse depending on what color the mates said the fish were hitting. These were fished on anything from a 2 oz. to 8 oz. jig head with or without bucktail and a bare hook teaser loaded with the same 6" Gulp. It is no secret that Gulp can be expensive. So, when we saw a boat regular, Gordon, dipping into his gallon jug stuffed with 6" Gulp grubs, we were impressed...had to be \$250 - \$300 worth of Gulp.

Don got things started with 2 keepers right away, then Bill with one. Walt was the only one of our group not fishing Gulp, but rather a 3-way swivel with sinker, white plastic artificial and a piece of squid on a long leader. Walt was catching fluke with regularity all day, but refused to step on any to push them into that 17 1/2" mark. The Marone brothers caught, Don caught, Bill caught, Gordon caught, the Captain caught (those were his poles that occupied the coveted bow fishing locations), the mates caught, Dave gave up gear. That was the way it went drift after drift - all caught, Dave gave up gear!

Then, on one of the last few drifts where we were able to hold bottom, Dave finally caught a keeper with his last heavy rig, which the next drift took away. Because of the increasing winds and our inability to hold bottom in the deeper reef location, the Captain announced that he would pull in closer to the beach and give us another 45 minutes of fishing. Unexpectedly, instead of fluke, the last few drifts were over a very large school of weakfish not more than 50 yards off of the beach. All on downsized offerings had fantastic action with keepers being caught with regularity. We returned to the Belmar Marina after 9 + hours on the Big Mohawk III, filets bag up and on ice and ready for the group picture.

It was 3:45 am, September 14, 2012 when Walt Narkiewicz woke up, fully dressed; sitting in the chair he sat down in the evening before after returning from the VHFC Fluke Outing! On a long day of good fishing, all had a great time!!!

**FISHING REPORT** from Russell Denton for September 12, 2012.

Pal Dennis and I started out on BH jetty at about 9 AM first cast was a keeper fluke,, which set the tone for the day.... fishing four different jetties and also the spaces inside produced seven keepers for us,, between 17.5 inches to a 23 inch,,5.1 pounder,,,,,best part is no gas bill for the boat,,a casting pole rigged with a 1.5 to



2 oz. jig and plain hook dropper ,,one foot above ,, both baited with white gulp 4 inch curly tail grubs is all you need ,,plus a little patience to retrieve more slowly then you are used to ,,with maybe a little jigging action thrown in for good measure,,,throw backs ranged from 8 inchers to many,,, many,,, really nice 16.5 inch fish,,, it would be crazy to try to tally them... great way and a really fun fishing experience is what this is.....word from fisherman's HQs is that the fishing is like this from 70th to 80th St. in brant beach and also from 20th to 30th in ship bottom... it sure is worthwhile to give this a try , a nice walk on the beach and supper too....rjd2

### **FISHING REPORT** from Dave Spendiff for September 11, 2012.

Although my plan was to do some yard work, today was just too beautiful to waste in the yard, so, I went fishing. I've gone out a couple of times in the last few weeks with just artificals in an effort to find some of these big weakfish I keep hearing about. Nada! Not even a little one. Today, the eleventh anniversary of 9/11/01, I headed south and thought I'd fish the area where the ICW and middle grounds meet, an area that produced some small weakfish for me early this summer when I was fishing for fluke. I started fishing the last 1 3/4 hours of the outgoing. Water temp. was 68 and there was a light wind out of the NW.

I'll swear, I believe the bottom of this bay is a solid carpet made up of black sea bass, sea robins and blow fish. a lot of action but what I was hoping for. Just as the tide turned, I headed down to the Holgate rip area and started drifting with the incoming. The wind had turned to the ENE but was still light and didn't alter the drift much and certainly didn't change what was waiting for my gulp! The day was passing quickly and I wanted to head for home before 3 pm and I decided to go back where I started late this morning. The drift took me into the "no wake zone" near Morrison's but continued to produce the pesky bass and robins. Time

was a wasting and I decided to make two more drifts. I was fishing a 3/8 oz. jig with 4" chartreuse Gulp mullet. Squeezing the most out of the last drift, I went past Morrison's and drifted up into 8' of water and had a hell-of-a hit that immediately took drag. When I finally got a look at the fish I could see that it was a nice weakfish. With every run it took drag and I was concerned that the 10 lb. leader would hold. My folding net was not unfolded and caused more concern as I fumbled with it while trying to control this fish. Finally, fish in net, then in the live well and boat headed for home. I took the fish to Dave at the American Sportsman and it weighed in at 3.67 lbs. /oz. It was the only weakfish I caught today and that one fish MADE MY DAY.

### **FISHING REPORT** from Joe Filice for September 10, 2012.

Fished the surf again this afternoon. Not as hot as yesterday, but managed about 2-dozen with this 21" keeper. What a terrific few days this has been. Well over 100 fluke and 9 18+" keepers.

**FISHING REPORT** from Joe Filice for September 9, 2012.

Took son Mike & grandson Tyler out to same jetty as yesterday. Fished north side again and caught 30 with these two keepers for Tyler. Came home lunch and then returned to the beach and fished mid-way between two jetties after I went in for a swim and found the trough 15 feet off the beach to be over my head? Result was over 40 Fluke, I stopped counting, with two more 19" keepers. I've been in Beach Haven since 2001 and have never had this kind of fluke fishing in the surf. We will be back out today for more fluke madness.

**FISHING REPORT** from Joe Filice for September 8, 2012.

Word was fluke on north side of the jetties. My youngest son, Mike and I hit the beach at 9:00. The Jetty I wanted to fish had two guys already fishing the north side and pulling in fluke. We tried the south side with nothing. I looked south and noted that the next jetty down was empty. So we hoofed it down the beach and set up on the north side fishing a plain 1 oz. jig with a white teaser. Both baited with white 4" Gulp swimming mullet. MIKE'S second cast yielded a 20" from the wash just off the beach. Over the next hour and a half we caught two-dozen fluke with four keepers from 18" to 20". I lost several larger fish in the wash. Believe we could have limited out, but had company coming and had to leave the fish biting.
