

ATTENTION NEW JERSEY BOATERS APPROVED BOATING SAFETY COURSE NOW AVAILABLE ONLINE! THE "NEW JERSEY BOAT OPERATOR" IS APPROVED AND AUTHORIZED BY THE NJ STATE POLICE MARINE SERVICES BUREAU

In New Jersey, all persons operating any powerboat or PWC (jet ski, sea doo, etc.) must have proof of passing an approved boating safety education course. All operators, regardless of age, must possess an approved boating safety education certificate.

<u>GET YOUR NEW JERSEY BOATER CARD IN 3 EASY STEPS</u>

- 1. Take and pass the New Jersey Boat Operator Online Boating Safety Education Course and print your "Proof of Completion" document.
- Call and schedule an appointment to take the final exam at any our approved testing centers.
- 3. Show your 'Proof of Completion' document at the testing center along with a photo ID. The final exam must be taken in person and a passing score of 70% or better is required to obtain your New Jersey Education Certificate. BS^{core} of F. BorTei, Schorg Cor/Se
