Original Village Harbor Fishing Club Founder passes Away



Ed Cherry is Recognized for 21 Years of Service to VHFC

VHFC FOUNDER HONORED AT MAY MEETING by Ray Williams

Ed Cherry was awarded an Honorary Lifetime Membership to the VHFC at the May meeting. We truly appreciate all the things he has done for our club and for fishermen in the past quarter century. Here is his story & the story of our club:

21 years ago, things were a lot different in Manahawkin. A lot of fishermen were moving into the Village Harbour & Beach Haven West sections of Manahawkin. Ed Cherry was one of those guys. He tried to get a little help in finding good places to fish & the techniques locals were using in the area. No one would share anything. The usual answer was "The fish are in the Bay" or some other wise remark. Ed decided to get together with a few of his neighbors to help each other out. The result was the Village Harbour Fishing Club. It was impossible to get people to serve on the board. The Board decided to disband the club. One member, Dick Vesper, agreed to reorganize the club. Dick got volunteers to help run the board. Gradually, our club has gotten its own identity. Today, just as when Ed founded the club, we are involved in

teaching members how to fish the area waters, socialize with fellow members & their wives, & be involved in fishing regulations & conservation.

During all those years, Ed, by choice, never was the President; instead, he worked behind the scenes, helping us to grow, working on the original website, & became very involved with fishing regulations. We all owe Ed a big thank you for his years of efforts. The first meeting was held in Ed's garage in 1987. 13 people showed up. The club was formed & Ed became member #1. His neighbor, Paul Turi was instrumental in getting the club started. Paul got the club "Non Profit" status. Initially, the yearly membership was \$5. Another guy who really helped the club grow was Charlie Kochka. Charlie was a member of the Elks Club & it seems he talked almost every Elks member into joining the VHFC! Before

long, membership was up to 246 members. The club would have an August fishing tournament with up to 150 fishermen participating.

Over the years, though, the club went through a crisis. There were only a few "real" fishermen & most members didn't want to help run the club. It.

Ed passed away on Wednesday May 27. RIP

2015 Trophy Fish of the Year Program.

The rules are simple: you have to catch a fish of the above species, take it to one of our official weigh stations to have it weighed and recorded on our official weigh-in forms. If you have weighed in the largest fish of a particular species for the calendar year 2015 then you win the FOY trophy for that species. **Note:** your dues have to be paid before you catch an eligible fish.

THE LEGISLATIVE REPORT

for the latest information. Also the Governor has signed off of the regs and the Stripped Bass bonus tag has been suspended until September 2015.

Summer Flounder and Black Sea Bass Regulations Approved

New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Commissioner Bob Martin signed a Notice of Administrative Change to open the recreational summer flounder season on **Friday**, **May 22, 2015**. The size and possession limits for summer flounder remain 18 inches and 5 fish per day respectively.

The Shore Based Enhanced Fishing Opportunity Program will continue for 2015 at <u>Island Beach</u> <u>State Park</u> (IBSP). This Program permits anglers to retain only 2 fish per day (NOT 5 fish) greater than or equal to 16 inches (total length) only at IBSP during the current 2015 New Jersey summer flounder fishing season, which opens on May 22, and remains open until September 26. The Program will be available to "shore-based" anglers only, defined as fishing from a pier, jetty, beach, bank, or marsh. These modified regulations do not apply to anglers fishing from a boat, kayak, canoe, personal water craft, or fish arriving to the shore by means of water craft.

Shore-based angling shall be by hook and line only. Unlike the 2014 fluke season, there will not be a check station for fluke measuring 16 to less than 18 inches. Anglers are required to retain proof of legal entry to IBSP (park receipt) until returning home or until just prior to consumption if the fish are to be consumed prior to the angler returning home. Those holding Mobile Sportfishing Vehicle Permits are required to request a receipt at the front entrance gate of IBSP. The two fish at 16 inches or greater for shorebased anglers are the regulations on IBSP - anglers **can not** choose to retain 2 fish at 16 inches or 5 fish at 18 inches, it is 2 fish at 16 inches only. Anglers that possess summer flounder harvested at IBSP may harvest summer flounder outside IBSP provided they abide to the 18-inch size limit and 5 fish possession limit applicable to all other waters (for example, if 1 fish is harvested at IBSP, 4 fish 18 inches or greater may be harvested in waters outside of IBSP).

ATTENTION NEW JERSEY BOATERS APPROVED BOATING SAFETY COURSE NOW AVAILABLE ONLINE!

THE "NEW JERSEY BOAT OPERATOR" IS APPROVED AND AUTHORIZED BY THE NJ STATE POLICE MARINE SERVICES BUREAU

In New Jersey, all persons operating any powerboat or PWC (jet ski, sea doo, etc.) must have proof of passing an approved boating safety education course. All operators, regardless of age, must possess an approved boating safety education certificate.

GET YOUR NEW JERSEY BOATER CARD IN 3 EASY STEPS

- 1. Take and pass the New Jersey Boat Operator Online Boating Safety Education Course and print your "Proof of Completion" docum
- Call and schedule an appointment to take the final exam at any our approved testing centers.
