NEW JERSEY FISHING REGULATIONS by Phil Simon - Phil and his wife are on vacation in Greece and he will report out on his return. There are still three state scheduled public hearings in early October for New Hampshire and Massachusetts on the Striped Bass Draft Addendum VI. Sometime after the hearings, ASMFC will release their recommendations.

Draft Addendum VI proposes management options for both commercial and recreational sectors in the ocean and Chesapeake Bay to reduce total fishery removals by 18% relative to 2017 levels. The proposed measures include reduced quotas for commercial fisheries and changes in bag limits, minimum sizes, and slot size limits for the recreational sector. Since catch and release practices represent a significant component of overall fishing mortality, the Draft Addendum also explores the mandatory use of circle hooks when fishing with bait to reduce release mortality in recreational striped bass fisheries.
