#### NEW JERSEY REGULATORY & EXCERPTS from JCAA MEETING by Phil Simon

Not much to report this month, as JCAA has suspended meetings till next month and the various fisheries councils and commissions appear to be conducting minimal business as well. JCAA conducted it's "Heavy Hitters Fluke Tournament" in August, a state-wide event which allowed for parties of up to four to select one day out of three to fish the tournament and the winners were determined by the combined weight of three fish. As you might expect, those fishing in more northern waters have the advantage as the fish tend to grow in average weight as you move up the coast. This was born out by the winning team fishing out of the Highlands. Hopefully, next year JCAA will be able to return to its traditional format of running separate "ports", each in a sense a separate local tournament.

The pandemic is not stopping the annual LBI Surf Fishing Classic, which runs from October 10 to December 13. This tournament features lots of daily prizes. More information should be available soon at the website lbisfc.com.

The ASMFC has agreed to tie its menhaden quotas with the welfare and status of the striped bass stock, but its not clear yet just how this will be managed and what the results might be. This will certainly have to be a long-term approach, and it will take some trial and error before we can expect to see positive impacts on the striper population. Meanwhile we can expect to see the bunker reduction boats continuing their operations in our waters for some time to come.

**2020 FOM** - The largest fish by length caught during the time periods stated in the table below will be awarded a \$50 gift certificate to Fisherman's Headquarters (no expiration). There are 22 awards for 2020. Note: bluefish must be at least 22" for award consideration.

Bob Dodds took the August Fluke FOM with a fat 25" fish that went 7 lbs and Brian Leary took the seabass award with a 16 1/2" beauty. Congratulations Brian and Bob! There are 4 contests presently for entry during September - Winter Flounder, Weakfish, Sheepshead and Fluke. See the Table below for all 2020 FOM awards.

**RECIPE by Ed Valitutto -** This month's recipe is a simple grilled tuna sashimi that I often make as an appetizer. Buy one or two of the freshest steaks you can find. I personally like Blue Claw Seafood in Surf City where I have been getting locally caught Big Eye Tuna steaks. First, take the tuna out of the fridge a good 60 - 90 minutes beforehand. You should do this with any meat or fish so that the middle isn't ice cold when you serve it. I then apply a good dash of EVOO, salt & pepper and liberally sprinkle sesame seeds on both sides. Place the steaks on a hot grill or pan for 90 - 120 seconds depending on how rare you prefer the meat.

Slice the steaks across the grain about 1/4" thick. The grain is clearly visible in the first picture. I serve the tuna with a sauce of a few tablespoons of Mayonnaise, a squeeze of lime, a little soy

sauce, a teaspoon of sesame oil and a few drops of sriracha or your favorite hot sauce. The right photo is the finished steak - hard to tell but it is very rare.






