NEW JERSEY REGULATORY & EXCERPTS from JCAA MEETING by Phil Simon

JCAA held its first general meeting since June, but I have to say not much of importance occurred. I did learn that the recent "Heavy Hitters" fluke tournament was a financial success, with about \$10,000 raised for the organization. JCAA is still hurting for funds however as they had to cancel so many events this year due to the pandemic. It looks like JCAA will cease

mailing out hard copies of its monthly newsletter, due to the high costs of printing and mailing. We will be attaching PDF versions of the newsletter to the VHFC newsletter distribution list.

The ASMFC and the MAMFC, the two main regulatory bodies for fishing in our area, are having their annual get-togethers in the next couple of weeks. One of the items on the table is a series of proposals to re-allocate the split for summer flounder between the recreational and commercial sectors, which has been set at 40/60 since the 90's. Because of the reset of the fluke biomass estimates that occurred last spring, and also due to the fact that we now know that the old allocations were based on faulty data, there is a good chance that the allocations will be re-done to provide more for the recreational sector. There has also been some discussion of setting up a separate piece of the pie just for the party boats and charter boats, but this seems to be a little more problematic. Hopefully I will have more to report on this next month.

Division of Fish and Wildlife - The 2020 Striped Bass Bonus Program is still open. Due to COVID-19, applications must be submitted by email to application. Application Deadline is October 31.

2020 FOM - The largest fish by length caught during the time periods stated in the table below will be awarded a \$50 gift certificate to Fisherman's Headquarters (no expiration). There are 22 awards for 2020. Note: bluefish must be at least 22" for award consideration.

Larry Leary took the September Fluke FOM with a nice 22 1/2" fish. No one entered a Sheepshead so that FOM is closed. Congratulations Larry! There are 6 contests open for entry during October - Winter Flounder, Weakfish, Blackfish, Striped Bass, Seabass & Bluefish.

Special Note - Last month, we reported Brian Leary as the Seabass FOM winner with a 16 ½" fish entered on August 22nd. However, Bill Figley entered a 16 ½" seabass caught by Rosemary Figley on the 9th that was inadvertently missed in our records. Per the FOM rules, same size entries go to the earliest entered. However, since it was our (VHFC) mistake, Bill will also receive a certificate along with a belated congratulations!



RECIPE by Ed Valitutto - This month's recipe was a handout from Jim Hutchinson Sr from a meeting where Jim was the guest speaker - back when we actually met in person. I thought i would reprint it for those not in attendance. Jim brought an ample supply of the Hot Crab Dip for attendees to enjoy and it was outstanding. I'm sure the other recipes are equally as good. Thanks Jim!

HOT CRAB DIP

1 Pound Crabmeat

1 Cup Mayonnaise

1 8-Ounce Package Cream Cheese

1 Minced Medium Onion

2 Minced Scallions

1 Tables of T

1 Tablespoon Lemon Juice

½ Teaspoon Dill

1/4 Teaspoon Hot Pepper Sauce

Pick through the crabmeat to be sure there are no shells. Soften the cream cheese and blend with a fork with the mayonnaise until all one consistency. Add all other ingredients except crabmeat and blend thoroughly. Fold in the crab and transfer to an ovenproof serving dish. Bake in an oven pre-heated to 350 degrees until bubbly and starting to turn light brown on top, about 30 minutes. Serve with your favorite crackers. Serves 6-8 as an appetizer.

MARYLAND CREAM OF CRAB SOUP

3 tablespoons flour 1 envelope hollandaise sauce mix

4 cups half and half-divided

1/4 cup butter

2 tablespoons Old Bay or more to taste

½ teaspoon dry mustard ¼ teaspoon celery seed

1 cup whipping cream

3 tablespoons cooking sherry

1 pound fresh crab

In a medium bowl blend the flour and hollandaise sauce and then mix with 2 cups of half-and-half. Melt the butter in a medium, heavy saucepan over medium heat. Slowly add hollandaise mixture, stirring constantly until thickened. Add the remaining half-and-half, Old Bay, dry mustard, celery seed, and whipping cream. Bring to a simmer and reduce heat to low. Add crabmeat and sherry, stirring gently until warmed through. Serve immediately.

TOASTED CRAB APPETIZERS

1 stick butter or margarine

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1 5-6 oz. jar Old English Cheese Spread

6-8 oz crabmeat

1 tablespoon mayonnaise

6 English muffins

Soften butter to room temperature. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix cheese spread into butter and stir in mayonnaise. Add garlic powder and stir all until completely blended-no lumps. Gently stir in crabmeat. Slice muffins in half and divide crab mixture on the 12 halves. Cut each half into quarters and place on a baking sheet. Bake in oven until cheese is bubbly and edges are brown. The spread can be made in advance and refrigerated for a couple of days. These may also be frozen before cooking for later use. Make the muffins up and cut into quarters. Freeze them on cookie sheets, and then place in zip loc bags for storage. They will keep a month or two without losing much flavor.

After a leisurely 8:30 departure, we anchored a few hundred yards off shore and it didn't take long for the puffers to find our chum slick. We kept 40+ large ones and left them biting. The bonus was three large kingfish, two of which were almost 14".



Last hurrah for 2020 fluke on The Jen-Jen on Thursday the 17th for the Leary crew. This would be the last day to Fluke fish due to upcoming weather. We went headed south off a wreck NE of LE Reef. It was a sporty ride out but we were able to keep 4 nice fluke. We also had 4 Sea bass up to 20" – shame we had to release them!



Dave Spendiff enjoyed a fine time fishing with his three sons with Capt Brett Taylor on 9/27. Starting at a small wreck off of Island Beach State Park, the tog were on immediately. We weeded through shorts before we limited out. We moved to the North jetty at the inlet with no luck on bass until my oldest son, Bill, hooked up a schoolie at the sod banks.
